

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

To the Members of the County Council

You are summoned to attend an EXTRAORDINARY MEETING of the EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL to be held at PELHAM HOUSE, LEWES, on WEDNESDAY, 15 DECEMBER 1999 at 2.00 pm to transact the following business:

1. Apologies for absence
2. Waste Local Plan – Deposit Draft

To consider:

- (a) the report of the Cabinet Committee
- (b) the following notice of motion by Councillors Jones, Reid, M Murphy, Barnes, Bagshawe and Tidy which the Chairman of the County Council has directed shall stand referred to this meeting of the County Council under Standing Order 36.8 :

"The County Council instructs the officers to finalise the Deposit Draft of the Waste Local Plan, in consultation with Brighton and Hove Council, as follows:

- accept the JoSPAC recommendations except that in respect of Veals Farm, Ripe;
- remove the possible blight to local communities near to Pookhill Barn, Selmeston and Marley Lane, Battle by ensuring that these sites remain deleted from the draft Plan; and
- site the western incinerator at Beddingham rather than at Newhaven."

(In accordance with Standing Order 36.8, the motion will be considered with the report of the Cabinet Committee and will be dealt with as a deemed amendment to paragraph 1 in that report.)

Following the advice of the Cabinet Committee, the Leader of the Council will move the following motion:

"The Council resolves to sit as a committee to consider the report of the Cabinet Committee and the issues contained therein and the motion set out in item 2(b) above and the recommendations to be made to the Council in relation thereto."

Assuming the motion is approved, the meeting of the Council will be adjourned by the Chairman, to resume at the conclusion of the meeting of the Council in committee.

- (c) [assuming the motion that the Council sits in committee is approved]

on the resumption of the Council meeting, a motion to be moved that the Council adopts the recommendations of the Council sitting in committee.

3. Special Responsibility Allowances Paid to Leader and Cabinet

To consider the following notice of motion by Councillors Jones, Sinnatt, Clements, Bagshawe, Barnes, M Murphy and Reid which has been referred to the County Council by the Chairman under Standing Order 36.9:

"This Council resolves to reduce the Special Responsibility Allowances paid to the Leader of the Council and the members of the Cabinet to £1 (one) per annum and to amend the Members' Allowances Scheme accordingly, in view of their failure to provide leadership in respect of the Deposit Draft of the Waste Local Plan."
